The Village of Roseville is offering recycling drop-off trailer services. Labeled, blue containers for recyclables are located on a recycling trailer at the Roseville Village Hall.

A Hands on Guide to Giving Your Trash a Second Chance!


Remember! Always place recyclables in the appropriately marked bins..and avoid breaking glass.


The Can-do list Rinse and remove lids on aluminum, tin or bi-metal cans that contained food or beverages. Labels do not have to be removed.



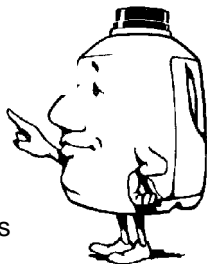
Plastic picks

Two types of plastic are recyclable. Look for the following symbols on the containers.

 PET -- soda type bottles

 HDPE -- Milk or water jugs, detergent bottles

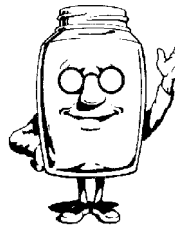
Remove all caps and rinse out containers. No styrofoam, plastic salad/fruit containers or plastic plates.



Paper

All paper must be dry! Paper products accepted are: magazines (TVGuides), file waste, white ledger paper, and mixed

paper (junk mail). Each of these types of papers have their own bins. *Please DO NOT MIX items! DO NOT BUNDLE* paper with twine, tape or string.



Don't pass the glass

Remove lids and rinse clear, green or brown unbroken glass. Be sure to place glass in the correct bin---sort by color. Green glass in bin marked "green glass" etc. Mixing colors will make the

contents of the bin non-recyclable. No windows, auto glass, Pyrex, light bulbs, ceramic or dishes will be collected.

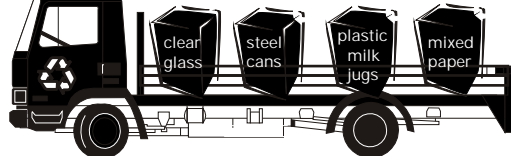
Your cardboard collection

ONLY corrugated cardboard is accepted. Flatten and place in blue bin marked "cardboard". NO chipboard such as cereal boxes, soap boxes, shoe boxes, beer and soda boxes, egg cartons or wax covered chipboard milk cartons are accepted.

All recyclable materials must be placed in an approved blue recycling bin.
